Today we will take a look at everyones favorite Bible story, the story of King Asa and his feet. "Wait? Who was king Asa and what did his feet have to do with anything?" you may ask. Ok so maybe this isn't the most well known Bible story, but it's a good one none the less. King Asa started out as a good king of Judah. He trusted in the Lord and removed the places of pagan worship from the land. God blessed Judah during the reign of Asa and delivered them from their enemies. Toward the end of Asa's life however, he began to trust human kings for deliverance instead of trusting the Lord, as a result Judah went from a time of peace to a time of war. At the end of Asa's life his feet became diseased, yet his trust was still in the power of men instead of the power of God. 2 Chronicles 16:12 says "In the thirty-ninth year of his reign, Asa developed a disease in his feet, and his disease became increasingly severe. Yet even in his disease he didn't seek the Lord but only the physicians." We must be careful not to make the same mistake as Asa. Even when we have seen the power of God we may sometimes be tempted to put our hope in human deliverance, but true deliverance is only found by trusting in God.
